Character Descriptions for Principal Characters

In Order of Appearance:

The Witch of the Eternal Winter:

A beautiful, icy enchantress that lives in the Land of Permafrost. She travels around the world looking for people that she can draw into her domain of ice and snow. Her goal is for the entire world to be under an eternal Ice Age. She succeeds in making Elsa a powerful ally to meet her goal.

Elsa:

Elder daughter and heiress to the throne of the Kingdom of Arendal. When Elsa was a young girl the Witch cast a spell on her that allows her to magically create and manipulate snow. As a result, she lives with great anxiety that her powers will become known. After many challenges she ends up serving the Witch and becoming a beautiful but icy queen.

Anna:

Younger sister of Elsa. Fearless and devoted to her sister she embarks on a perilous journey to find her dear sister and to save the world from an Eternal Ice Age. With the help of many friends on the way she manages to make it to the land of Permafrost. It is her gift of self-sacrifice and tears of true love that melt Elsa's heart and causes the Snow Witch to withdraw.

Freyja the Raven:

A woodland friend that introduces Anna and Elsa to the secrets in the woods. She is a constant cheerful companion and Anna and Elsa love to watch her dance in the sky. When Anna embarks on her journey she is one of the few birds that does not migrate to the South but follows Anna into unknown territory and saves her from many scary situations.

Princess and Prince of the Snowy Woods:

Guided by the Freyja Anna meets the Princess and the Prince as they glide on the sparkling ice at the Royal skating party. The kind-hearted couple provide for Anna a warm cape and gloves and wish her good luck on her journey.

Gypsy Robber Girl:

During the next leg of Anna's journey, she runs into a rowdy band of Gypsies. After an unfruitful day at the market the gypsies are tired and see the lonely girl as an easy target. They ambush Anna and the Gypsy Robber girl, the daughter of the robber hag, demands Anna to be kept for her as a play mate. She steals Anna's beautiful cape and gloves. Thanks to Freyja, Anna gets away.

The Norwegian Maiden:

Exhausted after a long night and day of travel Anna suddenly hears someone singing in the woods. Out of the woods comes a girl who was gathering berries from underneath the sudden snowfall caused by Elsa. She helps Anna by feeding her some of her berries and calls on her Reindeer, Sindri, to help Anna get further to the North.

Sindri the Reindeer:

In the old Nordic tongue, Sindri means “sparkling”. The Norwegian maiden named her “Sparkling” because of her unusual snow-white coat that seemed to sparkle in the sun and the moonlight. The beautiful Reindeer guides Anna into the lands of the frozen Tundra where no trees can grow. With her gentle spirit she brings Anna comfort.

Lapland Maiden:

Accompanied by the Lapland Maiden, Anna finds herself at the Finn Maiden’s earth dwelling. The joyful Finn Maiden invites them both to her roaring fire which warms Anna and brings her great encouragement. The Finn Maiden shows Anna the way to her final destination, the utmost North where no life exists.
